In Our Own Hands

Dirty Dozen, Bethesda, 10/17/11, 8:30pm

The last tropical depression had been gone for a few days now allowing Atlanta's sunny warmer weather to reassert itself and Monday night we played in nicer conditions that the previous week, with no spitting rain, mud or clammy air. The **Dirty Dozen** was in a divisional dog fight at 6-1, tied with **Bubba's** and the **The Dead Lois's** at 6-1.

The **Dirty Dozen** faced **DUCK!** while **Bubba's** would play the **Cricket Brew Crew** and **The Dead Lois's** played a double-header against **Get Dirty** and the **Reds**. We had beaten **Bubba's**, so we owned the tiebreaker there, but we'd lost to **The Dead Lois's**, so they claimed it in that direction.

We just planned on beating a 3-5 **DUCK!** team and hoped for help from **Get Dirty** in the first game of **The Dead Lois's** double dip. When we arrived at the park for our 8:30 game we found that **The Dead Lois's** had already beaten **Get Dirty** and were sitting around for an hour waiting to play the **Reds**. Oh, well. So, we just had to focus on beaten **DUCK!** and hoping **Bubba's** would beat **The Dead Lois's** the following week.

DUCK! had only beaten one of our teams, **The Cowboys** in Spring 2099, one time, back when they went by the **Warthogs**. Our teams were 13-1 against them overall, though, so we didn't expect a huge challenge. Not that we were about to overlook anybody! **DUCK!** picked up three players from the **Manbearpigs** and I signed off on it, letting them play the game with ten guys the pickups better than what they usually fielded.

We were Home team Monday night and took the field long enough for **DUCK!** to send four guys to the plate and leave the game in its pristine initial condition. In our half of the first we got the scoreboard dirty all over. We started with a ground-out and a double and went up 1-0 on a double from **Tim McCoy**. A pair of singles got Tim home, 2-0, then **Leroy Frazier** busted a deeeep one for a triple and the two runs put us up 4-0! A fleeting fly froze Frazier and a longer fly ended the inning.

We put **DUCK!** down quickly again in the second for no runs and went to work in the second very much like we had in the first. We led off with a fly-out then two singles. A double made the score 5-0 and we scored a sixth run on a ground-out. A single put a second guy on base then **Russell Ray** busted a deep shot for a two-out, two-run triple and we quickly led 8-0! A ground-out ended the second, but we'd built ourselves a comfortable lead.

We put **DUCK!** away 1-2-3 in the top of the third inning, but we went down 1-2-3-4 and the scored remained 8-0. **DUCK!** scratched the scoreboard in the fourth as they were able to push home an early inning error. We answered with a three-spot to lead 11-1 after four and we were rolling right along, despite the three pickups arrayed against us.

The *Manbearpigs* plated two in the top of the fifth then we held *DUCK!*, but still held a good lead. We didn't improve our lead in the bottom of five, but led 11-3. We threw *DUCK!* a donut in the sixth and they threw it right back, still 11-3 with one inning to go.

A weird thing happened in the bottom of the sixth, though. We were two runs away from a run-rule victory and had men on second and third with two down. One of our guys was at the plate, knowing that a base hit would seal the deal and the catcher started yapping at him. He briefly yapped back something to the effect of, "Oh yeah; watch this", then tattooed a low, flat 2-2 pitch like a bullet, but straight up the middle. The pitcher caught the bullet and on we went to the seventh inning on a good play by the pitcher. Business as usual, right? Not Monday night. The Virgin Mary was umpiring behind the plate. Ike "Broflovski" **Smith** was 1-1 with a walk. **Russell** "Sting" **Ray** was 3-4 with three RBI, "Slim" **Tim McCoy** was 3-4 with two and **Jason** "and the Argonauts" **Tyler** was 2-3.

The thing with the umpire bugged me quite a bit as I kept picturing, in some dim future, some arrogant umpire actually calling one of my guys out for hitting the ball where he had said not to hit it. We had finished the game with several minutes left on the clock, so I parked it behind the backstop and lit myself a cigar and waited. Our guy who'd hit the rip up the middle was talking things over with the pitcher. Everybody was good and all was well.

The Virgin Mary was killing time in the same general area behind Field 9 and a bunch of our guys were milling around as word floated by that the *Reds* were up on *The Dead Lois's* on a different field. My waiting paid off as the VM began to explain why he'd done what he'd done and how he'd had to take control and when he looked at me I said, "Blue, I think you've done lost your damn mind." To make a long story short I explained my position and got it all out and he promised toward the end of the thing to show me in the rule book where he can define safe zones for hitters. I had to stay officially mad as hell and stalk away angrily after I'd said everything I'd been needing to say, so I didn't get to see the end of the *Reds* game.

Fortunately, **Robbie Crider** called me on the way home and told me that the **Reds** had smoked **The Dead Lois's** 19-3, putting us smack, dab in the driver's seat! We've got one week to go, guys, and if we sweep our double-header, like we did to begin the season, we'll take home the T-shirts. Bow up hard one more time, guys!














What do the following players have in common?



Class of 1991 – 49 players – Rocky McCoy started playing in 1991 and co-founded McCoy Softball with his brother Tim.

This old fart has played 3436 games and leads the Class of 1991 in games played and has won a ton of Batting Titles and league and tournament championships.

Tim McCoy has played 3357 games and **Robbie Crider** has played 1655. **John Beal**, with 470 games, is fourth ahead of **Bill Bryant** with 433 games. **Frank Crider** rounds out the top six with just over 114 games played.

Class of 1992 – 118 players – Gregg Brooke was playing ball with Tim on a team called the *Bears*, which later turned into *Venom* on Sundays. When we had a spot open on our original coed team, *Rocky Horror*, we asked Gregg to play and the rest is history. Gregg was a solid glove and a practiced eye at the plate and he and I learned how to win games on the infield, first in coed then in Men's divisions. Many of us learned patience at the plate by playing with Gregg and has played 1306 games with us and Gregg's eye and lots of line drive took him to several Batting Titles and helped us to numerous championships.

Not too far behind Gregg stands **Carolyn LaRue** who played 922 games and **Bobby Wright** who played 697. **Gerald** and **Susan Chaney** and played 367 and 293 games, respectively while **James Jefferys** and **Julie** (Haire) **Williams** 194 and 187. **Rick Lamborn** is the other player in triple digits with just over 113.

Class of 1993 – 76 players – Deanna Dennis was on the Free Agent list at the Softball Country Club. *Rocky Horror*'s success at the end of 1992 prompted Tim and me to expand our one coed team into what would become a coed empire at the beginning of 1993. The SCC even asked us to field an extra team, just for a season, to help fill up a league. Deanna was one of the many women we invited to practice and she played with us for 1215 games. She was tough and hit the ball well while fielding numerous positions and won several Batting Titles en route to many championships.

The second biggest Class in McCoy Softball history has produced 15 players with 100+ games played. Dave Kyle played just under 789, while Dave Locke and Carol O'Toole are at 503 and 463, while Melanie "Mo" Cohen played 418. John Byrnes, Michele Byrnes and Carl Snezek sit at 245, 204 and 201. Mike Smith played 184, Ann Hamner played 141 and Todd Menefee played 121, while John Teeter played 114 games with us. Carol Kemker was with us for 104 games and Tim Pesola was around for 103, just ahead of Angelo Dale who played 102.

Class of 1994 – 39 players – Tim Foss came to us while we were making lemonade. When I was playing with Gregg on Venom one Sunday we had a couple of no shows and I was one of the guys running around the Softball Country Club complex looking for pickups. One of the guys I talked to was Tim Foss, who played with Venom that day and later joined our teams. Tim won a number of Batting Titles and helped us win a lot of championships and a lot of Coed Team of the Year awards. Many of Tim's 456 games were on very successful Men's teams.

Two other players from the Class of 1994 hit triple digits: **Marlene Foss**, with 336 games and **Darrell Bauer** with 211.

Class of 1995 – 30 players – Tom Frier came to us by way of a recommendation from Michele Byrnes, a coworker, and became one of our best pitchers while playing for a number of years. He was part of what can only be called a Coed Dynasty and won more than his share of Batting Titles and championships, while also playing on our Men's teams as they began to get their feet on the ground. Tom's invaluable dry wit, calm demeanor and never-say-die attitude helped us learn to win ball games in any circumstances and to shake off the losses.

Tom's played over 669 games ahead of **Jack Sumner** and his 332 games. **Shawn Sanders** was well over 100 at 135 and **Karen** (Cumberworth) **Locke** played 111.

Class of 1996 – 45 players – Dee Dee Lawson started playing with us from the SCC Free Agents list and played with us for a solid decade. She was part of numerous coed championships and won some Batting Titles along the way while we transitioned from the SCC to County and City leagues. When I handed Dee Dee her first First Place trophy she told me she'd never won anything before and I'll never forget the look in her eyes as she took that trophy. That look and the sense of pride I felt is part of the reason I still coach. One day I'll hand each of you a First Place trophy.

Just behind Dee Dee's 398 games stands **Chris Martin** at just 289 and **Kristie Ahrenstedt** at 208. **Cheryl Martin** is at 195 and **Jana** (Black) **Paulk** is sitting on 166.

Class of 1997 – 49 players – Norman Mapp started from a call to the SCC Free Agents list. In mid 1996 Tim and I had a practice and over thirty people showed. More than half of them were solid players, but we'd just needed a few guys to fill a few spots on our five teams. So, we started a new team to keep all those new players around and called it *Motörhead*. Norm was a member of *Motörhead* in 1997. Since that time, Norm has played on nearly every team we've offered and has won lots of championships and way more than his share of Batting Titles along the way. His 1079 games ranks him in the top ten of McCoy Softball games played. Norm's positive influence in the dugout continues to keep us loose and having fun, while focusing on the game at hand.

Also in that *Motörhead* practice were **Dave Yekell** at 360 games and **Vince Tuccillo** and **Wayne Archer**, who came from another source, both at 108.

Class of 1998 – 35 players – Russell Ray should play number 900 next season. He came from the SCC Free Agents list in the last year the SCC was in business and had his first practice while I was laid up in the hospital with the brain injury. Tim told me about Russ and **Steve Shreve** and how good they'd looked in practice and we had to find spots for them. I saw them play their first game from the bleachers and had to ask Tim, "Which one if the

big one again?" In Russ's 890 games he's played on nearly all of our teams, but has always loved his times with **Smoke on the Water**, precursor to the **Dirty Dozen**. At the beginning of 1999 Russ injured a hand at work and had to start the year on the DL. He came back with a vengeance, subbing and playing on multiple teams while winning numerous Batting Titles and championships. He's always given us toughness and grit and we look forward to his hitting a 1000 games played one day.

Behind Russ stands **Steve Shreve**, with 353 games and **Chris Allen** and **Jan Chappell** at 222 apiece. **Catherine Butler** played just over 115 and **Terri Kilgore** played exactly 100 games with us.

Class of 1999 – 14 players – Ruby Richardson came to us in a rather circuitous manner. The Softball Country Club closed down in February 1999 and we were scrambling to find places for our five teams. Many players went other directions while we focused on Gwinnet County and Snellville city leagues. Toward the end of 1998 we'd contacted a player named Doris Hughes who played on the *Unusual Suspects* at the SCC. She agreed to play on *The Jets* coed team in Spring 1999, but when we had our first practice we learned that Doris would not be able to play with us. In her stead she said she'd send her sister. Tim and I were all bowed up about winding up with some unknown player, but once we saw Ruby Richardson play ball in the practice we shut up and counted it as a blessing. In the 341 games Ruby played she won plenty of Batting Titles and won many championships, including *The Jets* who played at Lucky Shoals and won nearly every game we played for a few years. Ruby played tough and could always be counted on in the clutch, some of her best games coming in Post Season Tournaments and you didn't want to look Ruby in the eye if you made an error.

Ivan Ruyle played 257 games with us, while Anthony Waight and Terry Moon played 189 and 180, respectively, for the Class of 1999.

Class of 2000 – 24 players – Larry Civelli came from a Free Agents list, but not from the SCC, rather from Briscoe Park in Snellville. The *Mixed Nuts* landed there after the SCC crashed and Larry joined us then. He was a standout player, but quickly gravitated towards the Men's side of things, though he continued to sub on coed when he could. Larry's big bat and sticky glove has anchored the *Dirty Dozen*'s outfield for years while winning lots of Batting Titles and championships.

He is at 393 games and just recently passed **Mark Nations** at 383 for most games played from the Class of 2000. The other triple digit player is **Gordon Williams** with 123 games.

Class of 2001 – 31 players – Freddy Allen came to us from Ruby Richardson. I needed a player for *The Cowboys* Fall State tournament and was stuck. At the Friday coed *Jets* game, I mentioned that I needed a player for the next day and Ruby spoke up about a guy she knew. I got Freddy's number from Ruby and he showed up for the tournament, bright and early the next day. Freddy's speed and defense were impressive and he could swing the bat as well and he quickly wound up on our other teams where he won some Batting Title and championships, while compiling 468 games. Freddy was one of those guys coaches loves. I could put him anywhere on the field and he would play well there.

Dean Binder is right behind Freddy with 438 games and should move into first place for the Class of 2001 in, say, 2017. **Howard Mathis** played 361 games and **Shane Mohr** played 106.

Class of 2002 – 28 players – Leroy Frazier came from the Gwinnett County Free Agents list and took an empty spot on the *Dirty Dozen*, where he's been a fixture ever since. Leroy has played outfield and first base and has turned into a rock solid pitcher. He's won a few Batting Titles and a few championships and has always been counted on for delivering big clutch hits. Leroy's easy going personality and competitive edge have helped shape what is now a solid veteran team.

Leroy has played 270 games and is head of **Darlene Crews** with just under 182, while **Jeff Whitley** played 166.

- Class of 2003 21 players Amy Parham came to us from a Free Agents list and first practiced with us in February 2003 where she wowed us with her offense and defense. She quickly became a fixture on both *The Jets* and *Mixed Nuts* and won more than her share of Batting Titles while accruing a number of championships. Her speed and ability to hit the ball hard the other way was a huge asset for her teams and kept her in the lead for homeruns among the ladies. Amy is the only player from her draft class to crack 100 games with 186, well ahead of Randy Croto with just 35.
- Class of 2004 16 players Steve Prachyl worked in the same building as Tim. The two got together and Steve started subbing with us in Fall 2004, then jumped on the *Dirty Dozen* to play Tundraball. He was a solid first baseman and, despite not winning a Batting Title, could be relied on for a clutch hit and numerous hot streaks at the plate. Steve is the only player from his class to bust 100 games at 176, way ahead of **Debbie Ellis** with 54.
- Class of 2005 19 players Quentin Cowans worked near Tim, I mean just a couple of cubes away. They soon got down to talking Softball and soon Quentin was subbing on The Jets (coed) now and then. Quentin, with his blazing speed quickly turned into a premier outfielder and has given us a ton of booming hits. He's won a few Batting Titles and a couple of championships while playing 203 games. He's the only one over a 100 from 2005, way ahead of Dena Wheeler with 49.
- Class of 2006 19 players Steve Brewer leads the Class of 2006 with 74 games played, well ahead of Lauren Brown and her 27. Steve came to us from us from a Gwinnett County Free Agents list and was quickly placed on more than one team. He played coed and Men's and won Batting Titles and champions in both genres. He was a solid infielder with a strong bat and would have been a fixture now if he hadn't had to move out of state for work.

- Class of 2007 25 players Dave Lindeke was playing with Tim on a Sunday church league and eventually started subbing with our teams in Summer '07. He quickly joined a couple of our teams as a regular player and was in the mix early on when the *Jets* turned into a Men's team. He finished second the first two seasons for the *Jets*, but never won a Title or a championship. Dave delivered us a lot of clutch hits in his 131 games and is just ahead of **Pablo Isern** with 108.
- Class of 2008 30 players Elden Kasmier came to play with us the long way around. I was at Bethesda Park one evening watching Liz play a coed game and when I arrived I was asked to keep an eye on a stray pit bull who'd been found at the park. While I was sitting in the bleachers watching the dog and holding the leash I said something to a guy sitting behind me. We got to talking about how he was out there looking for a team and how I had several teams and pretty soon Elden Kasmier was playing with us regularly. Elden has played first base with us and a little outfield, but mostly pitches. His blend of pitching and the ability to field the position make him a natural and one of our best. He recently won his first Batting Title and seems destined to win more. He also won a championship with *The Cowboys* and helped get the *Jets* off the ground. Elden is the only triple digit player from 2008, way head of Chris Sprague at 66 and Don Harris at 60. Liz and I took the dog home while we sent out flyers to find his owner, but he did not play well with our dogs and quickly wound up at the pound. Elden we kept.
- Class of 2009 39 players Andy Matz was a football player who wanted to play Softball. We got him from the Gwinnet County Free Agents list. We were impressed by his hitting and his fearlessness in the field, running down fly balls. He started when 2009 did and has been a fixture on more than one of our teams ever since. When I put Andy on the infield it just clicked and since then has become a solid second baseman who also spot starts at third, short and first. Andy has already won a couple of Batting Titles, but I still need to hand him a First Place T-shirt.


Andy's 146 games are a few games ahead of **Jason Tyler** and his 139 and **Troy Kelly** just played his 101st game, not too far ahead of **Guarionex Montano** and his 82 games and **Jonathan Brivette**'s 65.

Class of 2010 – 40 players – Adam Baker came from a Free Agent list and first practiced with us in late summer 2010. His speed and quickness were immediately evident in his defense and he hit the ball like crazy. We added him to a couple of teams and he played with us for the better part of a year before having to give up his regular spots due to work. He quickly won a *Motörhead* Batting Title and has given us numerous big hits. His defense is solid on the infield or outfield and he is an asset in the dugout helping keep us loose and focused. His unselfishness is the kind of thing any coach likes to find.

Nobody who began in 2010 has played 100 games yet, but Adam leads with 84, just ahead of **Josh Carper** and his 71 games. **Keith James** had played 57 and **Mike Massey** just hit number 50.

Class of 2011 – 21 players – Dave Fisher came to us from Adam Baker, who recommended him to us. He first practiced with us in February 2011 and has been playing on a team or two ever since. Dave has played good first base and outfield and has been close to a couple of Batting Titles. His hot streaks can be really hot and one of these days soon he's going to win a little man. I also need to get him a First Place shirt pretty soon.

Obviously, nobody has cracked 100 yet from this newest class, but Dave is in the lead with 49, just one game up on **Bill Sarubbi**. **Rob Stewart** is in the neighborhood with 42, just ahead of **Mike Reams** and his 38 games played. **Chris Barker** stands at 30 while **Scott Morgan** sits at 23.

ASA Bat Testing & Certification Program

The official bat in ASA Championship Play must meet all of the requirements of Rule 3, Section 1 and:

1. must bear either the ASA approved 2000 certification mark or the ASA 2004 certification mark as shown below, and must not be listed on an ASA non approved list, or





- 2. must be included on a list of approved bat models published by the ASA National Office; or
- 3. must, in the sole opinion and discretion of the umpire, have been manufactured prior to 2000 and if tested, would comply with the ASA bat performance standards then in effect.

Beginning January 1, 2004, all bats in ASA Championship Play must pass the ASA 2004 bat standard. All bats having the 2004 certification mark will be allowed in ASA Championship Play. Bats that have the 2000 certification mark will not be allowed in ASA Championship Play unless they are listed on an approved bat list on the ASA website. For convenience, the ASA website has a listing of bats that do not pass the ASA 2004 bat standard.

For a list of bats that have been tested and found to comply with the ASA bat performance standards, and therefore are authorized to bear the ASA 2004 certification mark and/or are authorized for use in ASA Championship Play beginning January 1, 2004, please click on the manufacturer below.
