## The Jets, Lucky Shoals, 11/2/01, 8:00pm

Oh, boy did we hit! Three singles and an out got us a run, then Rocky "Mountain" McCoy doubled for a second run and we were tied, 2-2. A ground-out put us up 3-2. Have I mentioned, yet, that we hit? We hit, alright, especially with two out. "Fast" Freddy Allen's ** two-out single plated a run, 4-2, then Dee Dee "Awesome" Lawson hit a bomb for a triple and we led 5-2! Five straight, two-out doubles from "Life of" Brian Oringderrf, Nancie "Sluggo" Goodman, Tom "Young \& Tender" Frier, Jan "the Man" Chappell and Tim "MAY!" McCoy drove in five more and we led 10-2! Deanna "Sausages" McCoy singled for a run, 11-2, then a single and a walk loaded the bases for Freddy "Still Fast" Allen who singled for a pair and we led 13-2, before a fly ended the inning. We batted 18 times in the inning, scoring 13 runs and Tom Frier, Tim, Deanna \& Rocky McCoy and Freddy Allen were each 2-2 in the first. Eleven straight Jets reached base after we had two outs.

We gave the Techs a knot hole in the second and hit some more. Brian "Golden" Oringderrf roasted a shot down the line for an inside-the-park homer, 14-2, then we got a double and made two straight outs. Of course, that's when The Jets get nasty... Tim "ber!" McCoy was next and his two-out double plated a run, 15-2 and Deanna "Flip" McCoy singled for a run, 16-3. Two more singles loaded the bags then Freddy Allen "Wrench" struck for a single and we led 17-2 before a fielder's choice finally stopped us in the second.

Another hole in the top of the third left the score 17-2, then we put up another four spot to make it 21-2. We led off with a TKO, then four straight singles and a double got us three runs. A ground-out got us the fourth and another ground-out ended the inning. Toyo needed a five spot to stay in the game in the top of the fourth, but all they got was another donut and we won the game 21-2, via run-rule.
